


Virtual Card Set #2 Rules Updates



Yoda

This new Yoda is a monster with a saber... Note that while he can knock out battle cards, Sith Force Push will in fact turn off Yoda's weapon!


When it comes to "fight together" cards, be sure you're ok with the order you put your cards in... or you might not get to use the weapon with the character you wanted!
For example, if you have three Battle Droids fighting together, and only one of them is getting the site bonuses, you might want to have him going first, as he would stand the best chance of survival.



Yaddle

She studied an ancient forbidden Jedi secret... and she's one of the only Jedi who has the knowledge.

So... how does she work? You have to decide to use her power as soon as she's revealed in a battle, before any weapon destinies are drawn.



In Complete Control/Security Volunteers

Let's talk about these objectives... these new cards let you "save" a stackable weapon, such as a someone's lightsaber, so that when you play another copy of that character, they still have a weapon available.

Also, those people who are sneaky might use it as a holding area for a card from their hand so they can discard the rest then get it back. Of course, you still need to load this card up with a stackable weapon before you can do that... you have to have something to swap! :)

Bounty Hunter

All versions of Aurra Sing are considered bounty hunters.

Once Per

If a card has text that is "Once per turn/phase/etc." it can be performed once for each card you have that contains that text.

If a card has text that is "Once per game" it can only be performed once per game, no matter how many copies you play.

Face up

Some cards have text that grants a bonus to other characters, etc. To use these bonuses or text, they must be face up. This means that they have to have already fought in order to use the text.

For example, if you have a Galactic Delegate, and you'd like to have him add his power bonus to your senators, he has to be face-up to do so. (so he'll probably have to go early in the battle plan)
